Exodus 19-24

1. Last week, we saw the grace and justice of God displayed in the Passover story. How have you experienced the grace of God over the past week? In the midst of the *COVID-19* pandemic, what have been some of your observations about God's grace?
2. As a group, read Exodus 19. This passage of Scripture introduces the Mosaic covenant. In Exodus 19:3-7, what does God say is required of Israel to experience the fullness of this covenant?
3. How is the Mosaic covenant different than other covenants seen in Scripture, particularly the New Grace covenant? Discuss your thoughts on these covenants as a group. How does this New Grace covenant affect your daily walk with God?
4. Individually, read 1 Peter 2:9-10. Peter writes that we have a new identity in Christ. What are the four titles attributed to the church in this passage?
5. These four titles given to the church are: a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation and God's prized possession. As a group, discuss how each of these four titles shapes your identity.
6. The world is in a time of anxiety and fear as the new coronavirus has continued to spread. What godly potential do you and your family have for "such a time as this?" Over the next week, develop a plan for how you can *THRIVE* and seek to become like Christ in all of life.
