Bible Story: Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7, emphasis on Matthew 6:25-34)

The Jesus Storybook Bible: The Singer (228 – 235)

Main Point: Jesus teaches that God cares for us, so we should give our worries to Him.

Questions to ask:-

- Why do you think Jesus cares if we worry about things?
- Why do you think Jesus said what he did about birds and flowers?

Week of September 20

Bible Story: Selection of the Disciples (Luke 5:1-11 & 6:12-16)

The Jesus Storybook Bible: Let's go! (210 – 213)

Main Point: Jesus told His disciples to tell others about Him, and we are Jesus' disciples when we trust in Him.

Questions to ask:

- Why do you think Jesus picked these 12 men to be His disciples?
- What can we do to serve God and follow Jesus like the disciples did?

Week of September 27

Bible Story: Jesus Calming the Storm & The Transfiguration (Matthew 8: 23-27 & 17)

The Jesus Storybook Bible: The Captain of the Storm (236-242)

Main Point: Jesus is the Almighty.
