

2/3/19: FIGHT! (John 10:1-10)

1. As Dr.Cassidy said in the sermon, The world that we live in has two realms. There is the **natural realm**, with which we are very familiar. But our world also has an **invisible, spiritual realm**.” These realms overlap each other...they are not isolated. The spiritual world is at war and we are part of this spiritual war. As John 10 states, “the thief comes only to steal, kill, and destroy.” Satan seeks to seperateus from God. How have you seen this spiritual war affect your life or your families life?
2. Read Acts 5:3-4: Who is Peter calling out in these verses and why?
3. We need to be sober minded, meaning that we should be ever watchful. Being able to recognie when the devil is spreading division and confusion. Can you think of a time when you were not practicing situational awareness and satan was able to attack? What became of that situation?
4. Read John 10:3-4: Why is it so important for the sheep to know the shepherds voice?
5. We must know His voice. The Bible is full of the promises of God for guidance, help, and correction. While this verse is a metaphor, the idea is, He knows us and we are to know His voice. Communication with God is **constant**, but we don't hear it, because we are **not listening**. What communication methods do you employ currently to communication with God? How can we better this communication with God?
6. Read 1 Peter 5:5; in this verse whom does it state God gives grace to?
7. We must humble ourselves! Remeber the previous sermon series?...it's not about us...we must avoid pride. How are you avoiding the entrapment of pride? What have you learned from the previous “It's not about me” sermon series?
